Chorus:


Living He loved me, dying He saved me

Bernard's Gardening Tips

for April



- With the coming of warmer weather, jobs that need doing in the garden increase.
- Weeds are growing rapidly and need to be kept under control.
- Feed hungry shrubs and roses with a multi-purpose fertiliser.
- Tie in climbing and rambling roses.
- Now is the best time to sow new lawns and repair bare patches.
- Do not let the grass grow too long before mowing. For the first mow of the season the cutters on the machine must be raised. It is also a good idea to rake the lawn first.
- Sow hardy annuals and wild flower seeds outdoors.

I noticed the word cackleberry as there is a Cacklebury Close in Hailsham and I was always amused by the name. According to *Sussex Dialect* a cackleberry is an egg (a cackle berry - get it)? There is so much more. Another one – a darling or dawlin was the smallest pig in a litter or an unhealthy child. The meaning of that word has changed!


